**Notification: April 26, 2019**  
**Camera Ready: May 6, 2019**

The Symposium on Computational Fabrication invites the submission of high-quality, previously unpublished, novel technical work in computational fabrication. Papers may be up to twelve pages (including references) in SIGGRAPH article format. Submissions should be anonymized for double-blind review. Accepted papers will be given a 15 minute presentation slot at the conference and will be archived in the ACM Digital Library.

### Posters, Demos, and Short Talks

**Submission Deadline: June 3, 2019 (23:59 GMT)**

SCF also welcomes descriptions and demonstrations of late-breaking or recent (previously published) work relevant to the computational fabrication community. Submissions will be juried, and submitted materials will NOT be archived in the ACM Digital Library in order to allow the submission of early work without limiting future publication opportunities.
