Project Poster Sessions (**REVISED**)

Wednesday, Dec. 2nd and Thursday, Dec. 3rd, 1:30pm-2:50pm, WeH 5409

1 Instructions

Rather than having oral presentations to present your projects to the class, we will instead have poster sessions on the last two days of class. The advantage of poster sessions is that they are interactive: you can ask other people questions one-on-one, and you can prioritize your time based upon which projects interest you the most.

We will provide the easels, posterboard, and tape. You should bring up to **eight** 8.5x11" pages to tape onto the posterboard. When you first arrive, you will tape your pages to the posterboard, put them on your easel, and then you are ready to go. (You can keep the posterboards at the end.)

One member of your group should stand near your poster while the other group member(s) circulates to ask people about their posters. You will take turns doing this, so everyone will spend part of the time presenting their poster, and part of the time asking others about their posters. The poster sessions are open to the public. Please feel free to invite others to attend them.

2 Schedule

Because we have such a large number of projects this year, we will be spreading the poster session across two days: December 2nd and 3rd. Otherwise, if we did all of the posters on one day, there would be very little time per poster if one attempted to visit each poster. The poster sessions will be held in the usual time and location for our lectures (i.e. 1:30-2:50pm in WeH 5409).

I would like everyone in the class to attend both poster sessions (i.e. even on the day when your poster is not being presented), out of courtesy to the other groups. The revised schedule is shown below.
