Homework Hand-in Guidelines

- Homework assignments are a *required* part of the course and will amount to 25% of your grade.
- Homework assignments will include problem solving and short essay questions and minor program development tasks.
- Five to seven homework assignments will be handed out throughout the semester (every 2–3 weeks).
- Homework assignments will normally be due 2–3 weeks after being handed out. The specific due date for each assignment will be explicitly stated on the assignment.
- Homework will normally be due on a day on which class meets, and should be handed in at the beginning of the class.
- Homework will also be accepted without penalty until 5pm on the due date, if handed personally to one of the course instructors or deposited in a specially marked envelope on the TA's office door.
- Late homework will be accepted within 24 hours after it was due, subject to a 10 point late penalty. After 24 hours, late homework will not be accepted (except for pre-approved special circumstances), and no credit will be given.
- Sample solutions to the homework exercises will usually be made available.
- Please type-set your answers on a computer whenever possible. Diagrams and figures may be hand-drawn as necessary. Difficult to read hand-written solutions will receive no credit.
