#### 1 Submission and Dates

### 2 Groups

Your proposal should be O(2) pages. Your mid-term report should be O(1) page. Your final paper should be approximately a conference submission in size and depth.

## 4 Material, Research, and Other Classes

You are strongly encouraged to make the project research relevant for your group. Your project should (obviously) involve a problem of decision making or control and perform some kind of adaptive behavior. Finally, the project must be unique from that turned in for a grade in any other academic class—nevertheless, it may use the same platforms or explore different aspects of the same problem.
