#### **General Information**

The Doctor's Hooding ceremony recognizes those who have earned their doctor's degree and it gives the university an opportunity to emphasize the importance of graduate education in the life of a research institution.

- Each doctor's degree candidate will be hooded individually on stage by a faculty member of the candidate's choice.
- Each candidate is responsible for inviting a faculty member to participate in the hooding.
- Tickets are not distributed for the ceremony. There is no limit to the number of guests who may attend, although seating is limited and first-come, first-served. Guests are advised to arrive early.
- This is an academic ceremony. Caps and gowns are required for all participants. Cap and gown orders can be placed via cmu.edu/commencement.
- Diplomas will not be distributed and degrees will not be conferred at this ceremony.

All degrees (bachelor's, master's, and doctor's) will be conferred at the main commencement ceremony (11 a.m., Sunday, May 19, Gesling Stadium). All doctor's degree candidates should plan to attend the main commencement ceremony and wear their hoods as part of their academic regalia.

All diplomas will be distributed department/college diploma ceremonies taking place throughout commencement weekend.

## **Doctor's Degree Candidate Information**

Doctor's degree candidates who plan to attend the hooding ceremony must confirm the following information with their department's graduate coordinator:

- Your participation in the hooding ceremony
- The name of the faculty member you have selected to hood you at the ceremony\*

Confirm the above information by completing the attached form and returning it to your department's graduate coordinator by Friday, March 22, 2013.

\*NOTE: It is the responsibility of the doctor's degree candidate to select, invite, and confirm the participation of their faculty hooder.

#### **Announcements**

Graduating students may order personalized commencement announcements, which include the graduating student's name, school, degree, and graduation date. **NOTE:** Guests are <u>not</u> required to have a printed announcement in order to attend the ceremony. Tickets are not required for the ceremony and announcements simply serve as a commemorative souvenir.

## **Faculty Member and Department Head Information**

Doctor's candidates have been asked to inform their department's graduate coordinator of their participation and to provide the name of the faculty member who will be assisting in their hooding.

- Each doctor's candidate will invite a faculty member to assist in hooding him/her on stage at the ceremony.
- Candidates will be hooded alphabetically by college, department within the college, and then by last name. The only exception is Tepper, which will hood alphabetically by last name only.
- If a faculty member has more than one doctor's candidate to hood, he/she may remain near the stage to hood each candidate.

#### Department heads should be prepared to hood candidates from their department in the event a selected faculty hooder is not available.

Faculty who are participating in the hooding ceremony should plan to robe with the doctor's candidates at 7 p.m. in Rangos Hall, University Center.

Faculty members who are not participating in the ceremony are still welcome to attend as a guest, but they do not need to wear regalia.

A reception for all program participants, degree candidates, their families, friends and guests will take place in Rangos Hall and Schatz Dining Room, University Center at the conclusion of the ceremony.

## **Cap and Gown Information**

For Doctor's Candidates

All doctor's candidates attending the main commencement ceremony, Doctor's Hooding ceremony, or a diploma ceremony must order a cap, gown and hood.

- All August 2012 graduates: You must contact the University Store directly at 412-268-1032 to order your regalia.
- Order Deadline: March 18 at 5 p.m.
  Cap and gown orders can be made via cmu.edu/commencement.
- Caps, gowns, and tassels require a \$29 rental fee and a \$210 deposit. Gowns must be returned during the cap and gown return hours (see page 8) or the deposit will be forfeited. Graduates may keep caps and tassels.
- Hoods require a \$29 rental fee and a \$170 deposit. Hoods must be returned during cap and gown return hours (see page 8) or the deposit will be forfeited.
- Rental fees must be paid when ordering. Visa, Discover, and MasterCard are accepted. Deposits are due at the time of cap and gown pick-up. Only Visa and MasterCard are accepted for deposits. No cash or checks will be accepted.
- NOTE: Doctor's candidates will <u>not</u> receive a hood when picking up their academic regalia. Hoods will be distributed at the Doctor's Hooding ceremony.
- Candidates who do not attend the Doctor's Hooding ceremony can pick up their hoods during cap and gown distribution on Sunday morning (see page 8 for hours).

## **Cap and Gown Information**

#### **For Faculty Members**

All faculty members attending the main commencement ceremony, Doctor's Hooding ceremony, or a diploma ceremony must wear a cap, gown and hood.

#### • Order Deadline: April 1 at 5 p.m.

Cap and gown orders can be made via cmu.edu/commencement.

- Rental fees are as follows:
  - o Bachelor's cap and gown \$25
  - o Master's cap and gown \$26
  - o Master's hood \$26
  - o Doctorate tam and gown \$42
  - o Doctorate hood \$27
  - O Doctorate tam \$16
- With the exception of marshals and members of the Platform Group, regalia rental fees are charged to the academic department and an Oracle string must be provided when ordering. If the rented items are not returned by May 30 (see page 8), the supplied Oracle string will be charged all associated replacement costs on June 3. Replacement costs are as follows:
  - o Bachelor's cap and gown \$135
  - o Master's cap and gown \$160
  - o Master's hood \$125
  - O Doctorate tam and gown \$270
  - o Doctorate hood \$170
  - o Doctorate tam \$70
- From April 2 through April 20, late orders will be accepted by contacting the University Store at cap-gown@andrew.cmu.edu or 412-268-1032. A \$10 late charge will apply to all orders submitted after the deadline. No orders will be accepted after April 20.
