


Participants will begin processing from their robing locations to Gesling Stadium. As they enter the stadium, they will process into color-coded seating bays.

SPECIAL NEEDS

All campus buildings and Gesling Stadium are handicap accessible.

Campus parking lots/garages are also handicap accessible. On Sunday, the first floor of the East Campus Garage will be reserved for special needs guests. No prior arrangements are necessary.

Seating sections for guests with special needs will be available on the field in Gesling Stadium. Up to three guests are permitted to sit with a special needs guest in these sections. Sign language interpreters will also be stationed here. Tickets are not required; seating is first come, first served.


