EMNLP 2014 MOOC Analysis Workshop Challenge

The data you will work with for the shared task comes from an undergraduate Psychology Coursera MOOC with approximately 30K students. The students who participated in this MOOC were notified that the data would be used for research purposes. The protocol for data collection and analysis was approved by the Institutional Review Board at Carnegie Mellon University.

In order to be granted access to this data, you must be granted temporary inclusion in the research team at the Open Learning Initiative at Carnegie Mellon University. In order to move forward with that, you and each member of your shared task team (of up to 9 additional members) must complete the basic human subjects research training at <https://www.citiprogram.org/> and send a pdf or jpg of the completion certificates with this participation application. **Note that you do not have to pay any fee!** You should add Carnegie Mellon University as one of your affiliations. When it asks for your CMU email address, just type in your usual email address. And you can take either the Social-Behavioral-Educational Basic course or the Social-Behavioral-Educational refresher course.

You may also request a copy of the supplementary cMOOC dataset with 2,000 students.
