RESEARCH STATEMENT

The cognitive world of 21st-century children crosses between the physical and virtual in a way that evolution has not prepared them for. To succeed in a technological world, they need to develop application-based skills to negotiate the present and cognitive skills to easily adopt technologies that have not been invented, yet their development is very much grounded in multi-sensory experiences and play. Children in the developing world face particular challenges, as access to technology becomes synonymous with access to information and resources. My research focus has recently moved from access to specific technologies, namely spoken language processing technologies, to technology education with a global and evolutionary view. In particular: robotics education, combining physical and virtual realms; technology integration in primary school curricula; inter-cultural communication; impact of language technologies on language diversity.
