Call for Workshops — Submission Deadline Oct 31, 2008

Proposals for Workshops are solicited for the 2009 IEEE Conference on Computer Vision and Pattern Recognition (CVPR 2009) in Miami, FL. Workshops will be held on June 20, 21 and 26, 2009.

Appropriate subjects for workshops include topics from computer vision as well as topics from related fields or application areas. The primary criteria for workshop selection will be that the topic appeal to a significant cross-section of the community and that the organizers have a strong track record in the field to guarantee success of the workshop. As in recent CVPRs a passport system will be used. This means that room, coffee breaks and A/V equipment are centrally organized and there is no separate budget for workshops. Workshop proceedings will appear on the conference CD-ROM and will be indexed in IEEExplore. To propose a workshop or to obtain more information, please send an email to the Workshops Chair, Rahul Sukthankar (rahuls@cs.cmu.edu). A proposal should include the following information:

1. Title/Topic and sample call for papers;
2. Names and email contact of organizers;
3. Proposed length of workshop (1 day or 2 days);
4. Tentative program committee, and invited speakers, if any;
5. Relationship to previous workshops, if any;
6. Estimated attendance;
7. Date restrictions or preferences (June 20, 21 or 26);
8. Special space or equipment requests, if any.

The deadline for all workshop proposals is October 31, 2009. The selection committee will strive to make decisions by mid-November.
