Program Overview

HISTORY

Created by White House CTO's office in 2012.
Formalized through executive order and codified into law by Talent Act in 2017, which was the last law signed by President Obama. PIF has recruited 150+ Fellows and worked with 35+ agencies, impacting millions of Americans.

MISSION

The Presidential Innovation Fellows serve a leading role in designing, developing and harnessing technology and innovative solutions to better serve, protect, and empower all Americans.

HOW IT WORKS

PIF is an elite, nonpartisan innovation fellowship that brings in annual cohorts of 15-20 Fellows from around the nation. Fellows are hired as full time federal employees at the GS-15 level (\$142K) and detailed to agencies to work directly with program/agency leadership to solve their toughest challenges.

PROJECTS

Fellows work directly at the leadership level on early stage challenges that are of critical agency and/or national priority, with room to shape, define and lead initiatives.
