Requirements:

- 8-10 hours per week
- Attend weekly core, campaign, and planning meetings
- Meet weekly with your campaign coordinator or organizer
- Participation in the recruitment drive, Voter Registration Blitz Week, Get Out the Vote Blitz Week,
 And, Weekly 1 hour skills workshop
- Help 100 students register to vote before the deadline through events or on your own using studentvote.org
- Plan and run 2 virtual events for your campaign
- Recruit 5-10 volunteers

- Communication skills such as public speaking, writing to recruit and advocate, running meetings, and lobbying
- How to work with both traditional and digital media
- How to manage and train volunteers
- Hosting digital events
- Developing campaign strategy
- How to generate grassroots support
